POSITION	Crop Science Post Doctoral Research Assistant, full time Agronomy/Plant Breeding
LOCATION	Department of Crop and Soil Sciences North Carolina State University Raleigh, NC 27695-7620
JOB RESPONSIBILITIES	Post doctoral position in Crop Science for a candidate with a PhD in plant breeding or related area to coordinate a national team improving hairy vetch, winter pea and crimson clover for their use as cover crops. Cover crop use is increasing rapidly nationally but the scarcity of breeding programs has prevented the release of cultivars adapted to each region. Our consortium is also targeting traits such as soft seed in vetch, hard seed in crimson clover, and late flowering in all three species. The candidate needs strong communication skills to work with other members of the team, coordinate phone conferences with colleagues, assist in grant writing, and will develop manuscripts from past and future datasets. The candidate will be stationed in Beltsville Maryland working with ARS collaborators on the project. Other collaborating institutions include Cornell University, University of Minnesota, ARS-Wisconsin, ARS-Washington, and Texas A&M
QUALIFICATIONS	PhD degree in Plant Breeding, Agronomy, or closely related field.
